Müller Thurgau is a white-grape vine, that found its habitat on the porphyritic hills of Trentino since its arrival in our region, towards the middle of the last Century.

A balanced and refined Müller Thurgau ripens in high-altitude vineyards characterized by deep sandy loam soils rich in minerals.

Straw-yellow color with a hint of green, fresh and dry on the palate, Müller Thurgau Simboli features an elegant mineral sensation.

SOIL COMPOSITION

Porphyritic, moderately deep and
fertile

TRAINING METHOD

Guyot and simple Trentino pergola

PLANTING DENSITY

4.000 – 5.000 vines/ha

VINIFICATION

Hand-picking within the first half of
the month of September, soft-
pressing in an inert atmosphere,
controlled-temperature fermentation
in stainless steel tanks, ageing on
lees for approximately 5/6 months

ALCOHOL

12%

PAIRINGS

Light appetisers and fish-based
dishes. Excellent as an aperitif

10-12°
