## TEROLDEGO DOLOMITI IGT

Teroldego is a native variety of Trentino. The soil and climate in the vineyards along the Adige River are ideal for Teroldego. The Ora del Garda, a warm breeze that rises up from Garda Lake in the late evening, mitigates the temperatures in September, improving the grapes' ripening. Teroldego Simboli has a very intense ruby red colour and a fruity bouquet of raspberries and blueberries. It is dry, sapid and full-bodied on the palate.

<b>Vine</b>	Teroldego
<b>Vineyard location</b>	Municipality of Lavis
<b>Exposure and altitude</b>	West, southwest; 370 m a.s.l.
<b>Soil composition</b>	Deep, loamy, structured, averagely fertile
<b>Training system</b>	Guyot and simple Trentino pergola
<b>Planting density</b>	4,000-5,000 vines per hectare
<b>Vinification</b>	Hand-picking from in the last 10 days of September, controlled-temperature fermentation in stainless steel tanks and a small part in small oak barrels, ageing on lees in reinforced concrete tanks for about 5/6 months before bottling.
<b>Alcohol content</b>	12.5%
<b>Pairings</b>	Roasted meats, red meats, aged cheeses
